#### 1. Digital Literacy: Computer Labs at Schools and Colleges

Situation during the lockdown made everyone to go online in almost all aspects of life and we understood the advantages of advanced technology. We learnt how important it is to be computer literate. As a part of the Digital Literacy, effort of MyLittleBit Foundation, we've been working for the last decade, focusing on the underprivileged section in setting up Computer labs and extending computer education at government and aided schools and colleges.

#### **Proud Moments:**

Though schools were closed till October 2021, We continued our efforts in providing **Digital literacy to First Grade College** students.

Now the Computer lab at **Dharmasagara College is set up with 25 systems with an additional contribution of 5 Systems from MyLittleBit.** 

As the new NEP introduced Digital Fluency to fist grade colleges, we continued to teach students at **SVP College** and **Government First Grade College, Domlur** addressing around **150 students**.

We are happy to be back in action, as we restarted our Digital literacy classes at **Renuka High School** for 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> grade kids and at **Reddy PU College** for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> graders from **October 2021** onwards. With the new look to labs and refurbished machines, currently we have put 15 Systems at each school and looking to add more systems, addressing **65** students at Reddy PU College and **283** students at Renuka High School.



#### **Digital Literacy Annual Contest:**

Interested candidates are formed in to groups and they have chosen one of the topics listed below. Each student will be evaluated based on their presentation, topic coverage and slide preparation. Every participant will receive a participation certification and a trophy will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners. The contest will enable students on group activity, team work leadership capabilities, Presentation's skills and improves their language capability. This year students were made to present online which gave an added advantage to the latest trend of online learning.

We are glad to say that this is our 7<sup>th</sup> year in to this activity and we could support the girls from different streams of graduation. The girls were guided through personal career counseling and it has been heartening to see the progress of some of these girls.

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#### 3. Special Classes for Subjects:

Maths and Science are the subjects that every person finds it difficult to study, but we all know that bit of focus makes it easy to understand and one can score better with more practice.

An initiative started in the academic year 2016-2017 at Renuka High School, Kaikondarahalli, Bangalore, a government undertaken school. The activity aims at providing special classes for a small group of 8 to 10 girls, who are good in their academics, and are keen towards pursuing their education in Science stream. These girls come from an economically weaker section and cannot afford to take special tuitions either at private tutorials nor home tuitions.

We identified the teaching faculty from the same institution to ensure there is no change in approach to the studies for the selected students. The classes are handled 1 hour 30 minutes in the morning and evening, typically before and after school hours, by ensuring the students are attending their regular classes as well. Parents of the selected students are counselled in seeking support at home so that the girls are allowed for their extra classes and efforts.

We appreciate the School Principal and Teaching Faculty for their continued effort in making the students reach their highest potential.


As per the Government instructions due to the pandemic COVID-19, classes were partly suspended for the academic year 2020-2021 but it was heartening to see the students sailing through rough phase of their life. We are proud to say that these girls started to attend the special classes voluntarily during their 9<sup>th</sup> grade itself and that extra preparation helped them to do well in their 10<sup>th</sup> as well.

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#### 4. Uniform Drive:

As we know, every year, the school uniforms and shoes get wasted with hardly any avenue to get them utilized or recycled. However, there are a lot of tribal and remote schools (bridge schools/ tent schools) which have children coming in from extremely poor background and not supported by the Government. We help collecting the uniform & shoes from the Private Schools, which are further distributed to the underprivileged children.

The uniforms and shoes will be distributed through **RK Foundation**, a renowned organization for charitable action for clothes donation "VASTHRAVITHARANE" to schools in and around Bangalore and interior rural areas of Karnataka.

This was **initiated in 2016** with NPS Koramangala and has now scaled to **16 schools** in Bengaluru. We are extremely grateful to the wonderful support that we receive from Kumarans Schools, The Foundation School, Gopalan International, Shishu Griha, Whitefield Global School, Bethany, Greenwood High, NPS Indiranagar, NPS Rajajinagar, Inventure, Amaatra, Euro School, Deens Academy, VIBGYOR and others.

From 2017, we also did a donation drive in the apartments and received an overwhelming response. 10 apartments -Mantri, Embassy, Ranka Heights, Embassy Tranquil, Tata Sherwood, Elan and others.

What started as a collection of 500 uniforms from one school in Year 1 in 2016, went up-to more than 35,000 uniform sets and 4000 shoes in 2019. We distributed the uniforms to more than 40 schools in Karnataka- Govt School Clusters in Thoralakki, Mudgal, Kolar, Aalahalli, DN Dodli, Rao Gudlu, Hospet, Gidadapaalya, Shishu Mandir, etc









Every year Uniform Donation Drive activity is initiated in the month of December for that academic year and collection closes by April. RK Foundation will distribute the Uniforms and school related items to rural and tribal schools by the start of next academic year.

#### 5. Dreams Unlimited - Girls in the Workforce:

For the last few years, we've been driving various initiatives in the continuum towards empowering girls through education. We started with Computer Literacy in 2011, initiated special classes for Math and Science in 10th grade in 2016, Scholarships for girls for higher education simultaneously and we've been monitoring the impact in the journey.

In the process we realized that post the graduation, we significantly see a high proportion of girls dropping out of the mainstream. In our experience,

- 15% get married and drop off.
- 65% drop off due to lack of skills, opportunities and mentorship
- 10% get into post-graduation
- It is just 10% who get into the workforce and typically, they fall into the zone of going into factories and very low paying jobs.

To empower the girl child and bring about a substantial change with respect to the demographic dividend, educating underprivileged girls need to be prioritized. The key intent to focus on this critical area arose because of a few fundamental beliefs.

- With women participating in the economy, the entire society benefits
- When you invest in a girl, you're investing in a generation in rural India
- Empowering the girls to live up to their dreams

#### There was a need towards creating a Bridge for the underprivileged girls to enter the workforce

We identified a gap with industry required skills and skill set of girls coming out of the college along with the support provided by the family and society for the underprivileged girls. To fill the gap, MyLittleBit is delivering an Integrated Skill Development Program (ISDP) through service providers.

#### **Program Details:**

#### **Program Details:**

As one of the activities of MyLittleBit Foundation, a Philanthropic foundation, we introduced a project "Dreams Unlimited" a year ago, for underprivileged girls. Program aims to ensure the girls enter the work force.

#### **Objective:**

The objective of the program is to create a progressive *Integrated Skill Development Program (ISDP)* within the Academic Curriculum of the college for the students who are studying in BA, BCom, BSc, addressing all the 3 years and to see the girls are empowered to get in to the workforce.

#### **College Selection process:**



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Colleges are shortlisted based on the recommendations either through references or contacts where the fee structure is maximum of 30K per annum. The program is well appreciated by the principals and immediately they were happy to accommodate us by allocating 2 to 3 hours a day, 5 days a week.

#### **Curriculum Coverage:**

With the support of Principal and our service providers like TeamLease, JV Global, we created the curriculum which was inserted in their regular schedule to get them industry ready. Curriculum is tailor made to cover the practical aspects of domain and functional skills including creating PO, Invoice, Vendor development, Customer Service, Digital Marketing, etc

- **Numerical Aptitude**
- Verbal aptitude
- **Functional Skills**
- **Domain Skills**
- Soft Skills

The course delivery is more focused on the aptitude skill development and this assessed student's speed and accuracy, which is the crux to clear the first round of the interview.

Because of the extension of restrictions due to Pandemic in Bangalore, ISDP curriculum was tailor made to ensure that the students are made industry ready and get placed in their aspiring jobs, a Hybrid model is introduced where the students sit in the AV Room of their college and session delivery is through online for Soft skill, Numerical & Verbal Aptitude and IT Skills at the college lab.

- e. Offline: Digital Literacy in the respective College Labs. We conducted basic computing skills and trained the students in MS Word, MS Excel and Power Point presentations. We are happy to inform that, we were able to conduct this in small batches while maintaining social distancing and taking care of all the measures to safe guard students and trainers from COVID. In our Computer Lab we conducted a Power Point contest and was wonderful to see the students come and present on topics including- Covid 19 and beyond, Effect of social media and the Impact of Internet. It surely went a few steps forward to get them to first learn the tool and then present in English.
- f. Online: Because of the extension of lockdown due to the 2<sup>nd</sup> wave of Pandemic in Bangalore, and as the aspiring students were going to complete their graduation in few months, ISDP curriculum was tailor made to ensure that the students are made industry ready and get placed in their aspiring jobs. We delivered ISDP Aptitude training and delivered it online while the students could connect from their mobile phones in the comfort of their home.
- g. Hybrid: Because of the extension of restrictions due to Pandemic in Bangalore, ISDP curriculum is tailor made to ensure that the students are made industry ready and get placed in their aspiring jobs, a Hybrid model is introduced where the students sit in the AV Room of their college and session delivery is through online for soft skill, Numerical & Verbal Aptitude and continued our Digital Literacy at the college lab where ever possible. With the change in NEP, we are working towards covering the new curriculum for all 1st year students of First Grade Colleges.

#### **Placement Assistance:**

With the support of our service providers who are pioneers in bulk recruitments and with our personal contacts, we put our efforts to place the girls who have been mentored and trained under our initiatives at different organizations on Retainership/Internship/Trainee basis leading to Permanent roles.



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- k. We are proud to say that we could place the student amidst COVID situation and we have gone to an extent of arranging the computers and internet for online assessment and interviews. It was heartening to see our girls perform so well in assessments and interviews.
- It had indeed been a long journey from the inception of the idea to getting the ground level execution done. As always, any of these initiatives are only as good as the final outcome, which is getting jobs on hand. With uncertainties in the environment and avenues for jobs being unpredictable, it's been great seeing the girls getting their first jobs.

#### **Program Updates:**

With the supporting hand from respective colleges and in association with our Service provider JV Global, continued an Skill development program. St Philomina and Dharmasagara college continuing Hybrid model and Soundarya **College** switched over to **Online** during 3<sup>rd</sup> wave lockdown and Hijab controversy and switched over to Offline.

State Government announced closure of urban colleges and we continued our Online session to all the colleges except Domlur First Grade College and SVP College as students did not have either smart phone or feeble network connectivity in their residential areas.

We continued Digital Literacy classes at SVP and Domlur College. We had to call of ISDP training at Domlur college due to the lack of hours allocated and as the computer lab is shared with BCA students, computers were not available to address BA and BCom students and awaiting college to allot time slots once BCA students finish their practical classes.

## **Program Delivery:**

- 1. Course is conducted by Industry experts to give the practical aspect of work environment.
- 2. The course concentrates more on the aptitude and this assesses the speed and accuracy, which is the crux to clear the first round of the interview.
- 3. Course helps to improve student's communication skills which would aid them to communicate better with their team mates and make them to settle in the office environment at ease.
- 4. Resume or CV is the first point of impression about any candidate attending the interview and the course covered the points on how to prepare an impressive resume
- 5. Mock interviews will conducted which aids in overcoming their fear to face any interview.
- 6. Every Participating student with 80% attendance will receive a digital-certificate after completing the protocols assessed by the faculty.
- 7. Periodical tests will be conducted to ensure their preparedness. Attempting and excelling ensures to get their certificate.
- 8. Practice papers will be given to improve their aptitude and quickness
- periodically the student's attendance sheet will be shared with their respective college coordinator.
- 10. Classes are scheduled during college hours and our classes are integrated along with regular university curriculum, Monday to Saturday






