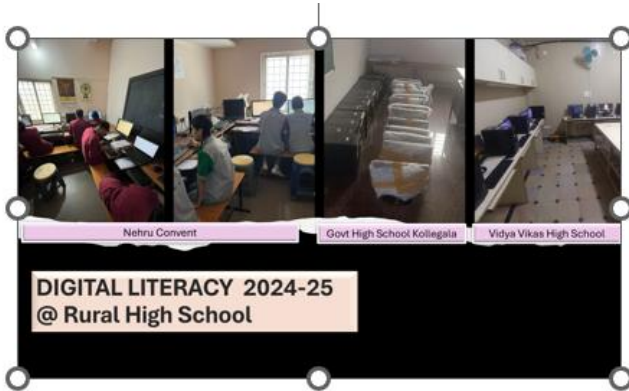

### 3. STEM SUPPORT PROGRAM AT RENUKA HIGH SCHOOL

#### 1. Overview

MyLittleBit has been passionately committed to advancing girls' participation in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) fields since 2016. One of our longest-running initiatives has been the **STEM Special Coaching Program** at **Renuka High School, Kaikondarahalli, Bangalore**—a government-run institution.

This program provides focused academic support in **Maths and Science** to academically bright girls from economically disadvantaged backgrounds who aspire to pursue careers in science.

#### 2. Objective

- To enhance understanding and performance in Maths and Science among girl students.
- To create a solid academic foundation for girls aiming for careers in STEM.
- To provide mentorship and support through alumni engagement and parent involvement.

#### 3. Program Implementation

- **Target Group:**  
8–10 academically strong girl students selected annually from economically weaker sections.
- **Subject Focus:**  
Maths and Science (Class 9 & 10).
- **Class Schedule:**  
Conducted **1.5 hours each in the morning and evening**, before and after regular school hours.
- **Faculty Involved:**  
Teaching faculty from Renuka High School, ensuring continuity in curriculum and teaching style.
- **Parental Engagement:**  
Parents are individually counselled to encourage home support and regular attendance.

#### 4. Highlights of 2024–25

- 🎉 **8th Consecutive Year** of the program at Renuka High School.
- ✅ Welcomed **10 new girl students** and held a special orientation for their parents.
- 🌟 **Introduction of Alumni Buddy Mentors:**  
20 past beneficiaries returned to guide and inspire the new batch.
- 👨🏫 **Dedicated Faculty:**  
Mr. Rajanikanth, a passionate educator, continues to lead the coaching sessions and inspire learning.

##### OVERVIEW

The Uniform Drive, which began in 2016 with just one participating school, has grown into a powerful movement spreading warmth, dignity, and hope across rural Karnataka. This year marks yet another milestone with overwhelming support from schools, residential communities, and corporate partners.

## 5. SCIENCE EXPO 2025: CURIOSITY SPARKS: IGNITING YOUNG MINDS IN STEM

**Event:** National Science Day – 3rd Annual Science Expo

**Date:** February 28, 2025

**Location:** Vishweshwaraya School, Konena Agrahara, Bangalore

**Organized by:** MyLittleBit

### 1. Objective

The *Curiosity Sparks* initiative was launched to ignite interest in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) among young students, especially girls, by making science education more **hands-on, practical, and experiential**.

The goal was twofold:

- **Equip government school science labs** with essential tools.
- **Celebrate National Science Day** through a student-led Science Expo.

### 2. Key Activities



#### Equipping Young Scientists

- Donated **scientific lab equipment** to **13 government schools**, based on individual requirement lists submitted by teachers.
- Enabled students to perform real-time experiments, moving beyond textbook learning.



#### Science Model Contest & Expo

- Held science contests in each school leading up to National Science Day.
- Culminated in a **Science Expo on Feb 28**, hosted at Vishweshwaraya School.
- **13 schools participated**, with over **150 students** showcasing more than **70 working science models**.

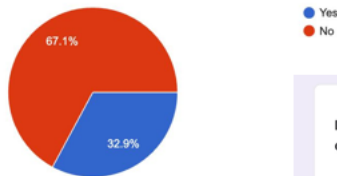


## Need for a Digital Lab set up in the College

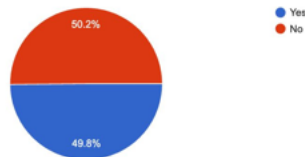
